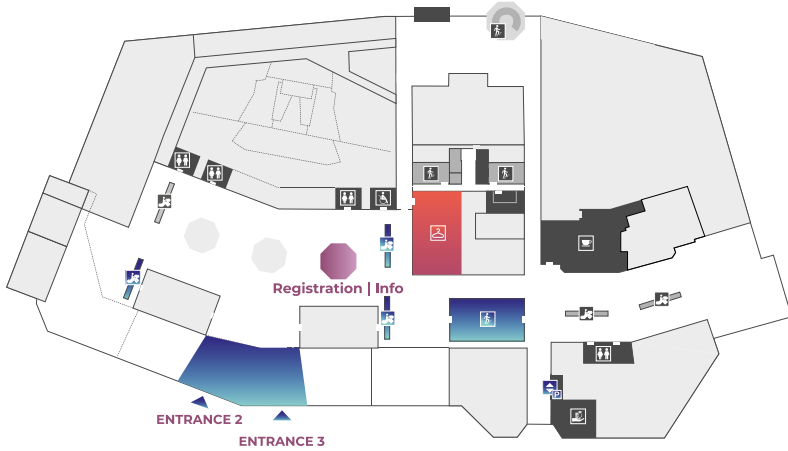

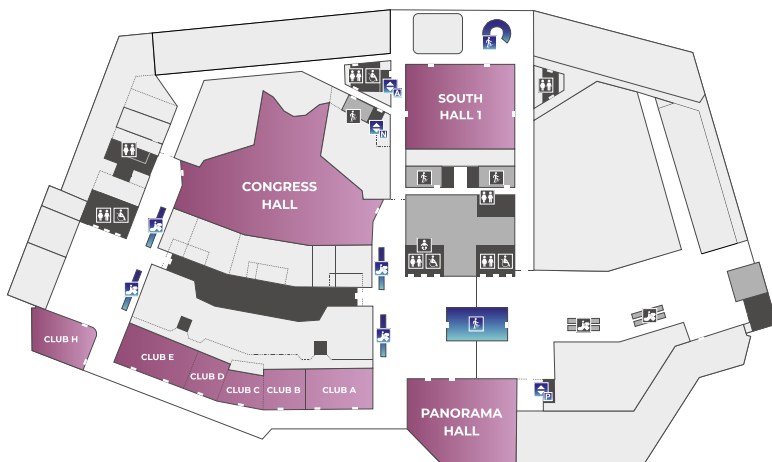


FLOORPLANS

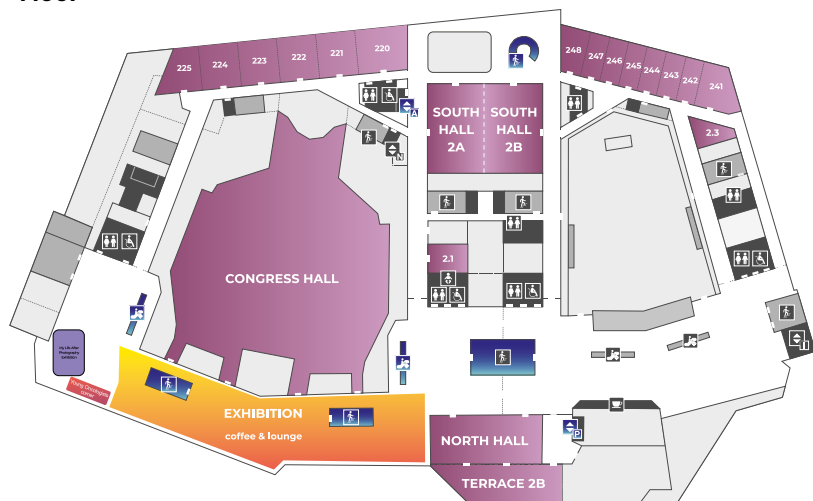
Ground floor



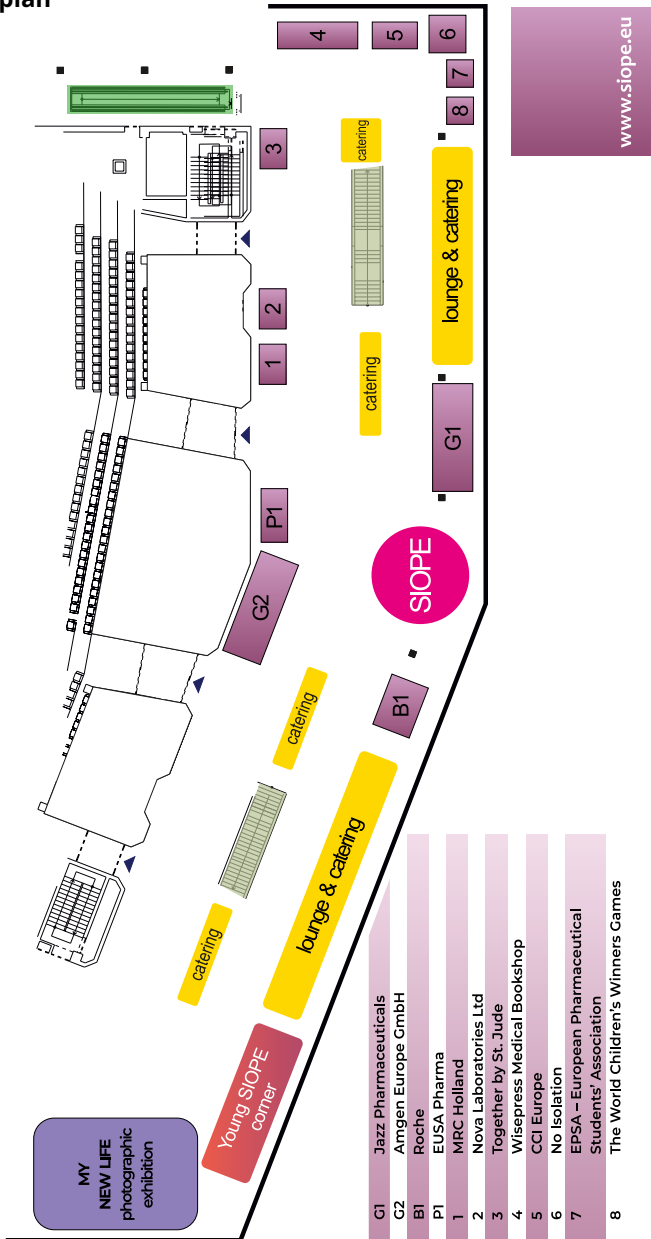
1st Floor
