MY NEW LIFE photo exhibition supports children who have been treated for malignant tumours. The project started in the spring of 2010 based on the initiative of Lucie Hrdličková (MD, paediatrician) working at paediatric oncology and Kamila Berndorffova (a fine arts photographer). Their shared intention was to present children afflicted with malignant tumours in an optimistic and hopeful way to both the non-professional and professional publics.

The goal of the campaign for MY NEW LIFE is to improve society's perception about young oncology patients. MY NEW LIFE showcases that these patients are regular kids with a passion for life. The campaign aims to remove the sense of despair and hopelessness attached to cancer in young people. Creating a positive public perception indeed contributes to young patients' mental well being and facilitate their recovery.

Kamila Berndorffová's singular large-format photographs present young patients who have been treated for malignant tumour in a unique manner. The photographs chronicle the true stories of the children, their families and their positive approaches to the future. The motto "Diagnosis of an oncological disease is not an end – it is the beginning of a new life", gave rise to the title of the photo exhibition and the entire campaign.
