The **Young SIOPE and ERN PaedCan Interactive Webinar Series on Most Challenging cases in Paediatric Oncology** has been a huge success since it started in 2021!

Therefore, we are pleased to announce that we will continue with this initiative in 2024.

Seven difficult clinical cases will be chosen for interactive webinars, in which a young oncologist (one of you!) will present the case (15'), followed by a live discussion with an invited expert (15').

As a selected presenter, you will be invited to participate in two preparatory meetings, with the expert and the moderation team, to guide you and maximize the quality of the webinar.

New this year, all selected presenters will benefit from a reduced registration fee to attend the 5th SIOP Europe Annual Meeting, taking place 13-17 May 2024 in Milan! Furthermore, presenters will be eventually invited to present their case during an educational session at the Annual Meeting or, if they will take part at the 2nd edition of the SIOPE Course in Pediatric oncology, during its 2nd module!

- the title of your proposed clinical case*
- a brief summary (max. 150 words) including a sentence with the key takeaway message(s)
- your CV

** Please, make sure that your proposed clinical case can be presented in a virtual and international venue, that it complies with GDPR, and that it adheres to your institution's and country's regulations regarding patient anonymity, consent and data protection.*

A committee formed by members of the Young SIOPE Steering Committee and of the SIOPE Education Committee, and representatives of ERN PaedCan will select the seven best cases, giving particular consideration to those with clear learning opportunities. The webinars are not intended to only discuss ultra-rare cases but have the most informative as well as challenging patients presented. Cases featuring innovative therapies (e.g., novel agents such as targeted therapies), controversial therapeutic decisions, complex ethical and/or patient management aspects, and cases highlighting multi-disciplinary efforts are specially welcome. The selection will aim to include a fair balance across different tumor types and countries of the presenters. The webinars will be CME accredited.

We very much encourage submissions! Presenting a webinar is a unique opportunity to gain visibility within the paediatric oncology community, as well as to get in touch with the top experts you will be paired with.
