Call for applications : **Fellow in Paediatric Haematology and Oncology 2021-2023**

The Department of Paediatric Haematology and Oncology of the Cliniques Universitaires Saint-Luc, Brussels, Belgium, is opening a position for a full-time fellow in training for the academic year 2021-2023, for 2 years from October 1st, 2021. These 2 years will be validated to obtain the Belgian title of Specialist in Paediatric Haematology and Oncology (2 year qualification).

Department :

University department composed of :

- 1 hospitalization unit of 14 beds
- 1 haematopoietic stem cell transplant unit (JACIE accredited)
- 1 day hospital with 10 beds

- Treatment of malignant diseases (+/- 100 new diagnoses per year)
- Stem cell transplants (15 per year)
- Consultation for benign haematological pathologies and immune problems
- Consultation on thromboembolic diseases and vascular malformations
- Long-term follow-up clinic and transitional medicine
- Medical team consisting of 5 full-time permanent doctors and 1 external consultants
- A paramedical team dedicated to the service consisting of 4 psychologists, 2 physiotherapists, 1 dietician, 1 care coordinator, 4 clinical and medical research coordinators, a paediatric liaison team + 1 school
- Integrated hospital allowing multidisciplinary and transversal activity

Candidate profile :

- Degree of doctor in medicine, surgery and childbirth valid in Belgium
- Diploma of specialist doctor in Pediatrics for October 1st 2021
- Registered in the Belgian Medical System (Conseil de l'ordre)
- Interest in paediatric haematology and oncology
- Ability to work in a team
- Additional qualifying factors: clinical and technical autonomy, scientific communications and/or and/or scientific publications

Role and responsibilities :

- Participation in consultations and management of patients treated in day hospital
- In-patient management of patients admitted for chemotherapy, treatment complications, stem cell transplantation or palliative care
- Supervision and teaching of assistants being trained in paediatrics
- Multidisciplinary work for the care of patients and families, with referring doctors and with the various professionals
- Participation in multidisciplinary consultation meetings and liaison staff meetings with the various professionals
- Participation in the department's on-call role under the supervision of the permanent doctors at night and at weekends
- Involvement in the department's quality projects
- Scientific communication or publication
