My name is Giuseppina Aloj. I am a pediatric oncohematologist. I have been working as a consultant in the Pediatric Oncohematology Unit of Santobono — Pausilipon Children's Hospital of Naples in Italy since 2018.

I received my medical training at the Federico II university of Naples. I achieved the specialization in pediatrics at the post-graduate medical school of pediatrics of the same university. During the residency, I received a 2-year training period in pediatric oncohematology working as a resident in the Pediatric Oncohematology Unit of Santobono — Pausilipon Children's Hospital of Naples and focusing my research work on late effects of oncological treatment during childhood.

In addition I spent a 4 month period in the oncohematologic ward of Saint Anna Children's Hospital and the Saint Anna Children's Cancer Research Institute (CCRI) of Vienna (June-September 2023) refining my training in the field.

I am an ordinary member of AIEOP (Italian Association of Pediatric Hematology and Oncology) and SIOPE (European Society of Pediatric Oncology) and I am involved in clinical trials on Acute Leukemias as study sub-investigator.

My main interests are actually hematologic malignancies, the late effects of antineoplastic treatment during childhood and supportive care.
