ITCC is looking for a dynamic, skilful and proactive Industry program manager to join its office. The selected candidate will help ITCC to run its industry strategy. The scope includes interactions with clinicians and researchers of the network, with large and medium size pharmaceutical companies, with the Paris Saclay Cancer Cluster (PSCC) and start-up companies (<https://www.parissaclaycancercluster.org>) as well as all stakeholders engaged on paediatric anticancer drug development.

ITCC is an academic European network and a non-for profit organisation registered in France (www.itcc-consortium.org). ITCC promotes the development of innovative therapies for children and adolescents with cancer. The network is composed on 68 paediatric investigating centres and 25 paediatric cancer research laboratories in 17 European Countries and Israel. ITCC collaborates with C17 in Canada and ANZCHOG in Australia. ITCC works closely with advocates who are deeply involved in the governance and activities of the network. ITCC works closely with large and medium size pharmaceutical companies to evaluate their adult drugs in paediatric malignancies and with start-up biotech companies to facilitate drug development targeting specifically pediatric malignancies.

The overarching goal of ITCC is to accelerate science-driven anticancer drug development to address the unmet medical needs of children and adolescents with cancer.

Main tasks will include:

- Development and monitoring of interactions with the ITCC P4 preclinical platform (<https://itccp4.com>)
- Development and monitoring of interactions with the ITCC PedCan portal (<https://www.pedcanportal.eu>)
- Support the ITCC Director of Operations in coordinating the advisory activity to pharmaceutical companies
- Implementation of partnerships
- Support to implementation of consortium programs
- Data generation to monitor Industry strategy implementation
- Act as a liaison officer on the Industry program within the network
