- \cdot Be creative/out of the box thinking/talented
- \cdot Be a fellow/trainee with experience in paediatric oncology (for at least 12 months) OR
- \cdot Be a junior faculty member (instructor or an equivalent, assistant professor) who has completed fellowship training within the last 12 months
- \cdot Be a maximum of 40 years (fellow/trainee) or 45 years (junior faculty) at the beginning of the Course (maternity/paternity/other leaves will be taken in consideration)

- \cdot 2 letters of recommendation (from experienced colleague and/or SIOP Europe member)
